An old kiln stands quietly in the silent forest. This invaluable structure offers a glimpse into Noritake's history. Here, you can envision the spirit and the passion of earth and fire from days gone by.

"Yoheki" Kiln Wall, which preserves the precious legacy and names of the donors for posterity.

Pieces of old bricks from the sturdy foundations of the early factory were excavated and used to construct a retaining wall. The wall is embedded with plates into which the names of donors to the Noritake Garden Foundation have been fired. This wall, which highlights our cherished history and warm supporters, is called the Yoheki Kiln Wall to signify our dedication to the kiln industry.
